Medicine Delivery / Pick-up:

3. [Rite Aid](#)- Online orders delayed 3-4 weeks (according to website). Healthcare professionals and pharmacists are available to talk **24/7 at 1-800-Rite Aid** or through a [live chat](#).
4. [Costco](#)- Costco members can order new prescriptions and refills for medications currently filled at Costco.com, 24 hours a day. They can be delivered anywhere in the United States.

Emergency Information on COVID-19:

- **Text Messages on COVID-19 from Suffolk County:** Residents can now sign up for SMS text message updates on their mobile devices to receive updates on the latest information, health guidance and other developments relating to the coronavirus. Residents should text COVIDSUFFOLK to 67283 to enroll.
- **Smart911:** County Executive Bellone is encouraging Suffolk residents to sign up for Smart911, which allows individuals to provide critical medical information to 9-1-1 and first responders. When someone calls 9-1-1, their Smart911 Safety Profile is automatically displayed, allowing public safety agencies to send emergency response teams to the right location with enhanced medical data, especially those who may need assistance not only during this outbreak, but during any emergency. You can create a Smart911 Safety Profile for their household at www.smart911.com or download the Smart911 App in the Apple Store or Google Play.
 - Individuals can also self-identify if they are under quarantine, and whether it is self-imposed or directed by a health professional. The Smart911 App allows quarantined individuals to receive check-in messages on their health status and sign up for alerts by Suffolk County to receive reliable information about the changing coronavirus situation.
