

List of acceptable and non-acceptable items:

ACCEPTED ITEMS

Aluminum: Cans, beverage and food containers, foil, pie pans, etc...please rinse/clean

Books: Hardbound and/or textbooks (covers torn off please), paperbacks

Cardboard: Paperboard boxes, corrugated boxes (flattened), egg containers, food boxes (including cereal and pizza boxes), frozen food packaging, mailing boxes and shoe boxes. All plastic or Styrofoam packaging must be removed.

Glass Containers: bottles and jars, rinsed/cleaned

Mail: Junk mail, catalogs, cards, magazines, newspapers, and envelopes

Metal: All types of metal including beverage and food containers, aluminum, tin, steel, iron, etc

Paper: All colors and types of un-waxed paper including folders, printer paper, office papers, non-metallic wrapping paper, school papers, shredded paper (in clear plastic bags only)

Plastic Containers (#1-#7): Detergent/bleach bottles, juice bottles, milk jugs, soda and water bottles, wide-mouthed containers such as cottage cheese, margarine, mayonnaise, sour cream and yogurt containers, drinking cups and empty prescription bottles including lids and caps.

Rigid Plastics: Including milk/soda crates, buckets, laundry baskets, plastic lawn furniture, plastic drums, coolers, plastic flower pots, watering cans, large water bottles, pallets, pet carriers, shelving, closet organizers and unwanted garbage cans.

Spray Aerosol Cans (empty)

Waxed cartons used for juice, milk or soups. Please empty and clean.

NOT ACCEPTED

Anti-freeze containers

Appliances

Batteries

Cat litter

Ceramics

Chemicals or household hazardous waste. No bottles or cans or oil, pesticides, gasoline or chemicals.

Coat Hangers

Contaminated paper products. No used napkins, paper towels, waxed paper, paper plates or tissues.

Drinking Glasses

Dry Cleaning bags

E-Waste* (tvs, computers, monitors, electronics, batteries, etc.)

Food waste

Garbage

Glass (window and mirror, auto)

Hazardous Waste

Hoses

Light Bulbs

Medical waste
