

Mayor's Report May 6th, 2025

The Village met with the NYS Department of Homeland Security Emergency Services to conduct a rapid risk assessment of the Village's IT infrastructure. The process took two days. Overall, the Village is doing well and will adopt DHSES's suggestions to improve the management of the Village data.

The Village met with the NYS Comptroller's office to listen to their summary of findings of the claims audit they conducted. This meeting is standard prior to the Comptroller issuing a final report. The auditors reviewed 232 vouchers totaling \$877,625. All of the vouchers were deemed to be appropriate expenditures. The final report will be issued in the upcoming months. Based on suggestions from the auditors, the Village has modified a few of its procedures and has made several changes in how it supports the monthly vouchers.

Police Officer Patrick Rogan has resigned from the Asharoken PD and accepted a position with the Northport PD. Pat has been on the APD for almost seven years. He was an exemplary officer, and the Village will miss him. I wish Pat all the best in his new career at Northport.
