Water Ski, Wake Board and Tubing Permit Application

The undersigned hereby applies for a permit to operate a vessel for the purpose of towing a person on water ski(s), wakeboard, tube, in the area known as the Outer Harbor of Duck Island in the Village of Asharoken. The vessel for which this permit is requested may not exceed twenty-one (21') feet in length and must have a below-the-waterline exhaust system.

NO PERSON SHALL OPERATE A VESSEL FOR TOWING A PERSON FOR WAKESURFING AND NO PERSON SHALL WAKESURF IN THE OUTER HARBOR OF DUCK ISLAND OR WITHIN (1,500') OF ANY SHORELINE WITHIN THE VILLAGE.

SAFETY RULES

Please read and follow the rules for your safety and the safety of other boaters, be sure to observe the following:

- 1. Do not have a skier, wake boarder or tuber in tow when entering the Outer Harbor of Duck Island Harbor.
- 2. When a skier, wake boarder or tuber is in tow, you must maintain a distance of 150 feet from docks, moorings and all other vessels, both anchored and underway. If this distance cannot be maintained, you must cease operation.
- 3. The yellow markers are used to designate the outermost perimeter of the towing lane. Vessels must keep these markers to the starboard side. Skiers, wake boarders and tubers must keep them to their right at all times.
- 4. When resting, leave the tow lane and move to the back harbor or to the mooring field in the center of the harbor. Do not anchor in the tow lane.
- 5. When retrieving a skier, wake boarder or tuber, you must observe the 5 mile per hour speed limit.
- 6. Vessels with amplified music must keep the volume at a reasonable level. Loud and continuous music which can be heard on shore is a violation of the Asharoken Village noise ordinance. Be respectful of the surrounding homeowners.
- 7. Water skiing, wake boarding and tubing in the Outer Harbor of Duck Island Harbor have become popular. Keep it fun and safe. You can help keep this waterway activity ongoing if you remember to be courteous and follow the rules.
